Northumbria university also offer a sandwich scheme whereby you can take a year off to do an industrial attachment before you return to the university to complete your degree. This is a great opportunity for you to earn a great working experience and money!

Students who completed the HND can proceed for their final year in accelerated entry into USA Johnson and Wales University. The articulation agreement with Johnson and Wales University gives accelerated entry to students who have the HND Hospitality onto their Bachelor of Science in Hospitality Management.

Work Permit in UK

International students who completed UK Bachelor or Master degrees will automatically qualify for 2 year or 5 year work permits in UK (HSMP -Tier 1 students) and if students successfully work in UK for 5 years, they qualify for Indefinite Leave to Remain (Live and Stay in UK)
