## **English Requirements**

While OSAC allows students to proceed into the course program they applied for, it is mandatory for all students to have a minimum level of proficiency in English. All students would sit for a English placement test to determine the level of English proficiency before the students is admitted to the relevant course program.

## **Academic Progression**

Students can proceed a do a Bachelor degree in UK, Australia, New Zealand, USA , Switzerland and France in Hospitality and Tourism.

Many UK universities, in addition to UK Northumbroia university welcome students into the second or final year of the Bachelor programme.

Students can also proceed to do the UK City and Guilds Master Professional Diploma in Strategy and Development( Hospitality and Catering) , as an alternative to academic Masters programs in universities. It meets the education requirements for full membership of the professional body (HCIMA)

## Career Progression

There are many career prospects – as F&B Assistant, Waiter, Head Waiter, Captain and Outlet Manager.

After the completion of 12 Months classroom training Students can do 6 Months paid internship\* in Singapore under training Work Permit.
