4. Return Air ticket (INR 60,000/-)

On Arrival:

TBILISI CITY – CAPITAL OF GEORGIA



Students are requested to carry a total of US\$ 5,000 in the form of travellers cheques (\$2,000) and cash (\$3,000), some of which can be changed into local currency on arrival at the airport. US\$ 3,500 is for University fees, \$500 for 2 months Hostel accommodation and \$350 is for Medical Insurance, Visa Extension (TRC Card) and airport pick up
Do not take a Bank Draft as this can take up to 1 month to clear the funds

A) Visa Process - Visa gets stamped on the arrival to the Tbilisi International Airport
Student may be asked following questions by the immigration officer at Tbilisi International Airport:

1. Why Georgia For higher Education?
2. What is your course of study?
3. Which university you have applied for?
4. Why this course?
5. Show me your academic documents (or may demand any other relevant documents. Only show as and when you are asked about the same)
6. What are your future plans?

B) Costs:

1. Visa Application fees - US \$50 by cash
2. Full tuition fees of US\$ 3,500 by cash
3. Extra US\$ 1,000 for Hostel Accommodation and living expenses
4. 1 Year Medi claim Insurance (US \$100)
5. Airport pick up and miscellaneous (US \$100)

Currency in Republic of Georgia - One Georgian Lari (GEL) = 25 INR (Indian Rupees)

- C) **Arrival:** Immigration at Tbilisi airport on arrival will check and verify that you have funds for full one year available – approximately GEL 6,000 = Indian Rupees 1.5 Laks. (Average Cost may differ depending on one's life style and daily standard of living)

Living Expenses:

Students are allowed to work part time while studying, and the earning rate is around 400 to 500 Laries per month. (Living Cost is Rs. 12,500/month - 500 Laries/month = 1.5 Laks/p.a.)

Monthly Rent = GEL 200 - GEL 250 = Rs. 5,000/- to 6,250/-

Monthly Food = GEL 150- GEL 250 = Rs. 3,750/- to 3,500/-

Monthly Bus Pass = GEL 25 = Rs.625/-

Monthly Metro Pass = GEL 35 = Rs. 875 /-

Indian Lunch (tiffin service of 4 roti and dal) GEL 90 = Rs. 2,250/-

Average gents shirts GEL 25 = Rs. 625/-

Average gents pant GEL 35 = Rs. 875/-

Self cooking & living in sharing is quite cost effective and cheap.



Georgia - is a sovereign state in the Caucasus region of Eurasia. Situated at the juncture of Eastern Europe and Western Asia, it is bounded to the west by the Black Sea, to the north by Russia, to the south by Turkey and Armenia, and to the east by Azerbaijan. Georgia covers a territory of 69,700 km² and its population is 4.385 million.

It is currently a member of the United Nations, the Council of Europe, the World Trade Organization, the Organization of the Black Sea Economic Cooperation, the Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe (OSCE), the Community of Democratic Choice, the GUAM Organization for Democracy and Economic Development, and the Asian Development Bank. The country aspires to join NATO and the European Union.

Tbilisi is the capital and the largest city of Georgia, lying on the banks of the Mt'k'vari (Kura) River in Eastern Georgia. The population is 1.5 million

Tbilisi experiences relatively cold winters and hot summers. The average annual temperature in Tbilisi is 12.7 °C (54.9 °F). January is the coldest month with an average temperature of 0.9 °C (33.6 °F). July is the hottest month with an average temperature of 24.4 °C (75.9 °F).

The hotel industry is very well developed in Tbilisi, so to study Hotel Management courses provides the best job opportunities
